Position Overview:

The purpose of a Resident Missionary is to join GoTEN missionaries living in urban refugee communities by engaging unreached people with GoTEN's disciple-making strategy (Prayer, Love, and Truth).

Essential Job Functions:

- Move into a refugee neighborhood and engage in relational evangelism with your unreached neighbors
- Make regular visits to non-Christian refugee homes and engage them with Biblical narrative through sharing selective stories
- Identify people of peace and start Bible story groups in their homes
- Participate in weekly staff meetings for coaching, team-building and strategic planning
- Participate and lead events to assist church partners in local engagement opportunities
- Assist the Ministry Site Lead in facilitating volunteer service opportunities for local volunteers
- Attend ongoing local training and prayer initiatives with GoTEN staff, volunteers and partners
- Participate in GoTEN trainings/mission trips as needed
- Receive coaching/spiritual direction on a monthly basis from GoTEN leadership
- Serve in GoTEN English classes or other GoTEN programs as directed by the Ministry Site Lead
- Raise financial support- Resident Missionary is a self-funded position at GoTEN

Experience & Working Conditions

- Some Biblical training recommended
- GoTEN will provide training for support raising, cross-cultural ministry, DMM, storytelling & missional living-- no experience required
- Must be – or willing to become – a participating member of a local church
- Is an active participant in a discipleship relationship, and actively disciples others
- Models financial health and integrity through Biblical tithing, generosity, etc.
- Weekly team schedule is flexible, though some Saturdays required
- Living incarnationally is a critical and unique aspect of this role. Resident Missionaries live in urban refugee communities where living conditions can sometimes be less than ideal.

Application Process

- Complete the online application at goten.org/careers
- GoTEN staff will contact you regarding your application, passion, desire and timetable
- GoTEN staff will contact references provided
- A series of interviews with Regional and Site leadership will be conducted through video conferencing or in person
- If the applicant seems to be a good fit for the position applied, GoTEN will extend a letter of acceptance to become a Staff Candidate.
- Staff Candidates are assigned a ministry coach to assist in preparations for joining the ministry field.
- Applicant will remain a Staff Candidate until 80% of ministry funds are raised.
- GoTEN will extend a letter of appointment with specific instructions on reporting to the ministry assignment.
